



RESOLUTION NO. 22-096

STATE OF LOUISIANA PARISH OF ORLEANS

Amendment/Extension to the Exclusive Right to Market Advertising Space on RTA Buses, Streetcars, Ferries, and Ferry Terminals

Introduced by Commissioner Neal seconded by Commissioner Walton.

WHEREAS, the contract between the agency and Vector Media (previously Laurel Communications) is set to expire on December 31, 2022.

WHEREAS, to improve the communication of passenger ferry fares, schedules, payment options, and special events schedule to riders. Vector Media will purchase and install two (2), installing information/wayfinding/advertising digital kiosks at mutually agreed upon locations at the Canal Street and Algiers Ferry Terminals at a cost not to exceed \$150,000.

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for two (2) kiosks includes but is not limited to equipment, permits, and necessary utility connections is \$150,000.

WHEREAS, Laurel Communications, the original contracting entity has merged with Vector Media and as such payments and correspondence shall be with Vector Media going forward.

WHEREAS, the purchase of the new digital kiosks will be charged to the account established for agency marketing as part of the annual budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Regional Transit Authority hereby authiorize the Chief Executive Officer to execute the amendment and extension to the Exclusive Right to Market Advertising Space on RTA Buses, Streetcars, Ferries, and Ferry Terminals with Vector Media until December 31, 2024 and thereafter would continue on a month-to-month basis until such time as either party terminates the contract by issuing the 30-day prior written notice to the other party and allows the purchase of two (2) information/wayfinder/advertising digital kiosksat mutually agreed upon locations at the Canal Street and Algiers Ferry Terminas at a cost not to exceed \$150,000.
