**AUTHORIZATION TO THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ENTER INTO A
COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REGIONAL TRANSIT
AUTHORITY AND THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS FOR THE PROVISION OF TRANSIT
SERVICES TO THE NEW ORLEANS POLICE DEPARTMENT ("NOPD") AND THE NEW
ORLEANS SANITATION DEPARTMENT ("NOSD")
MARDI GRAS 2022**

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 14(C) of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana provides that "For a public purpose, the state and its political subdivisions or political corporations may engage in cooperative endeavors with each other, with the United States or its agencies, or with any public or private association, corporation, or individual;" and

WHEREAS, the City and the Regional Transit Authority (RTA), also known as the Contractor, desire to accomplish valuable public health, wellness, and workforce development. The City has transportation limitations, which require additional transportation services to deliver New Orleans Police Department employees "*police officers*" and New Orleans Sanitation Department employees "*clean up personnel*" to special event sites. The New Orleans Regional Transit Authority, also known as the Contractor, will provide said transportation services. In addition, supply passenger buses, as well as experienced personnel and equipment operators to render resource transportation services during said events, including but not limited to the 2022 Mardi Gras parade season at the City's request; and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to provide the funding for the additional transportation services in the amount of \$60,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Regional Transit Authority hereby Authorizes the Chief Executive Officer to enter into the 2022 Cooperative Endeavor Agreement between RTA and the City of New Orleans.
