




TOTAL RIDERSHIP – BUS, STREETCAR, PARATRANSIT & FERRY:

System ridership saw a 4.4% decrease from the previous month.




BUS & STREETCAR RIDERSHIP | JULY 2023








RIDERSHIP AND OTP COMPARISON ROUTES 3 - 66








Bus: 5 daily average for the month, 1 bus increase from the previous month

Bus: 13 daily average for the month, 2 bus increase



PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE COMPLIANCE BUS, STREETCAR, AND PARATRANSIT: Fixed Route PM Compliance dropped in August due to PMs being done early and PM seeding. Factoring out PM's done early for correction fixed would be at 82% compliant for the month of August. Our PM Compliance Goal Remains at 90%.

FIXED ROUTE AND PARATRANSIT FLEET OVERVIEW JULY 2023



STREETCAR FLEET AVAILABILITY: Streetcar remained the same with availability between the cars for the last two months. We are currently waiting for red car inverters to come in.




ROAD CALLS PER 100K MILES BUS I JUNE 2023



ROAD CALL MILEAGE: Fixed Route bus has decreased in August compared to previous months, a goal of 13 mechanical road failures per 100,000 miles.




ROAD CALLS PER 100K MILES PARATRANSIT | JUNE 2023


