Justification:

An additional \$153,721.66 is needed to cover the cost of Task Order #7 and the upcoming Internal Safety Management Audits (ISMAs). As of now, ADS has a current available balance of \$53,046.75. However, Task Order #7 requires \$153,721.66. Task Order #7 will involve ADS assisting with Corrective Action Plan (CAP) deliverables to the State Safety Oversight (SSO). This task is crucial, particularly in the creation of a standalone Rail Operations Rulebook. The necessity for this rulebook has been underscored by the RTA Rail on RTA Bus accident that occurred in March this year, as well as other system-wide deficiencies identified during the APTA Peer Review and subsequent internal and external audits.
