Commissioner Colin stated that he wants to make sure that these new

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shelters were going to enhance the riders' experience and not become a nuisance to the public. The CEO stated that RTA works with the City of New Orleans when the homeless take up residence in the shelters. Commissioner Walton added that he would like to have all the shelters with the same look. It was also reported that all the extra shelters that are taken off the routes are placed into storage.
