RE: Request for base contract adjustment

Dear Ms. Quezergue,

Landmark Consulting and its subconsultants were awarded the Napoleon Avenue Building Renovation and Upgrade project in April 2012. This request is to modify our base contract cost totaling \$281,461.80. The original contract cost was based on a construction budget of \$2,298,878.00 and the current construction has escalated to \$5,147,179.90 including approved change orders for unforeseen conditions. Our basic services have not been modified to account for the escalation in construction cost over the last eleven years.

The job was delayed multiple times by the Owner, because of multiple changes to the scope, true budget, and project complexity. The Owner has agreed and paid for additional services to the contract for re-design and re-engagement of the project due to these delays.

Summary of Changes and Timeline

- Design Change Order#1- June 2013
 - Bid package for environmental remediation,
 - Perform testing and monitoring of environmental work to ensure code compliance and disposal of hazardous waste.
 - Structural engineering analysis of roof structure to correct problems discovered.
- Design Change Order #2- June 2018
 - Roof research, analysis and study based on SHPO requirements.
- Design Change Order #3- September 2018
 - Roof redesign based on study in CO#2 at 100% CD
 - Research window on both wood and aluminum manufacturers
- Design Change Order #4- March 2020
 - Re-engagement of design services was negotiated after being on hold.
- Alternate Roof Proposal- 9/8/2020
- Probable Cost (COVID) Proposal- 8/19/2021
- Rebid #3 Proposal- 12/8/2021
- Flood Permit Proposal- 6/21/2022
- New water and sewer line design and permitting- 2/9/2023



Summary of Complexity

This is a complex renovation project due to the number of requirements and unforeseen conditions.

- Funding sources: FEMA Public Assistance and FTA State of Good Repair
- Authorities Having Jurisdiction: SHPO, Levee Board, CNO, FEMA, FTA
- **Unique Building condition:** Historic building construction, structural damage at the foundation and roof, and environmental abatement.

Extended Overhead

The construction schedule has been further extended due to time extensions approved for repairs resulting from unforeseen conditions at the job site. The job is scheduled to be complete in October. Our engineering subconsultants have stopped work as there is not enough budget to complete the job. We are projecting additional hours per month to be incurred for construction administration services and construction closeout activities over a 5-month period to complete construction. The situation has created hardship for all firms due to the extended overhead and effort over the last eleven years to continue this very complicated project.
