WHEREAS, RTA is looking to develop a fully accessible system, regardless of service type and history; and

WHEREAS, the staff proposes to take the first step of a planning study as part of the FTA's All Stations Accessibility Program to develop a program of improvements to have <u>all</u> stops and immediately connecting infrastructure fully accessible for the thousands of residents and visitors that use this vital and scenic service; and

WHEREAS, this study will include developing stop typologies that meet both accessibility needs, beyond ADA, and fit the iconic historic context; and

WHEREAS, the study will also evaluate possible stop consolidation, to improve travel speed and reduce total program costs; and

WHEREAS, the RTA will be responsible for the local match of \$50,000. The federal obligation is expected to be \$200,000.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Regional Transit Authority (RTA) that the Chairman of the Board, or his designee, to apply for grant funding for the planning of accessible stations on eligible legacy rail corridors.
