WHEREAS, it is under this program that the RTA has traditionally qualified for funding; and

WHEREAS, the New Orleans Regional Transit Authority (RTA) is requesting \$5.225 million in federal funding to make enhancements to two facilities in its Ferry portfolio; Algiers Point Ferry Terminal and the Maintenance Facility located at Lower Algiers. Algiers Point Ferry Terminal currently is a single-story facility with a two-story vaulted ceiling; and

WHEREAS, the proposal is to enclose the ceiling and thereby adding a second floor. The second floor would be used as administrative offices for the Ferry Operations Team and the first floor would be used for ticket sales and rider convenience; and

WHEREAS, the Maintenance Facility has several building systems that are at the end of their useful life and need to be replace. These may include and are not limited to repairs due to termite damage, roof replacement and HVAC system replacements; and

WHEREAS, the RTA will be responsible for the local match if the grant is awarded. That amount is expected to be \$1,306,241; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Regional Transit Authority (RTA) that the Chairman of the Board, or his designee, authorization to allow staff to submit a grant application for federal funds for the Algiers Point Ferry Terminal Enhancement and Lower Algiers Maintenance Facility State of good Repair projects.
